Thank you for your interest in participating in our Accessible Vote-by-Mail Pilot Project, a new method of voting that allows disabled voters to use an electronic ballot to cast a secret, independent, and verifiable vote-by-mail ballot. This project is restricted to registered voters in Miami-Dade County, Florida, who have identified themselves as disabled and are eligible to participate in the 2020 General Election.

Here are the steps to follow if you would like to participate:

REQUEST TO PARTICIPATE:

- Email us at votebymail@miamidade.gov with your name, date of birth, address, and that you wish to participate in the Accessible Vote-by-Mail Pilot Project; or
- Complete and return this form via email at votebymail@miamidade.gov, fax at (305) 499-8401, or mail to PO Box 521250, Miami FL 33152-1250.
- Call (305) 499-8444
- Your request must be received no later than 5:00 pm on October 24, 2020.

RECEIVING YOUR ELECTRONIC BALLOT:

- You will receive an email when the ballot is ready. It will provide you the web link and instructions on how to access the online ballot, as well as provide guidance on how to return your voted ballot.
- Although you are able to print and assemble a return certificate envelope, the SOE office will also mail you a regular Vote-by-Mail packet that contains a backup paper ballot, in case you are unable to print your electronic ballot or if you simply prefer to use that certificate envelope instead of assembling the email version of the envelope.

VOTING YOUR ELECTRONIC BALLOT:

- After you have voted your online ballot, you must print it out.
- You may print the electronic certificate envelope or use the certificate envelope we send you to return the ballot. Be sure to sign or make your mark in the signature box on the back of the certificate envelope, regardless of which version you use.
- Mail your voted ballot to the Elections Office as quickly as possible so it will arrive no later than 7:00 pm Election Night or drop it off at a drop box.
- Your votes must be duplicated onto a ballot that can be processed by our tabulating equipment. This duplication is done by election staff under controlled conditions, so the integrity and secrecy of your vote is maintained.
