The Fair Housing Act, and other national and local laws ensure that persons with disabilities have the right to accessible housing, and to make reasonable accommodation to rules or policies that serve to restrict choice. Such rules or policies may restrict a person's ability to have a closer parking space, a ramp to one's home, or a service or emotional support animal. Other times, people with disabilities may be perceived as a danger or may be treated differently because of their disability. We work to get these rules changed.
