A great effort has been made by the arboriculture industry over many years to write quality standards and best management practices (BMPs) for pruning trees. Far too often, these standards and BMPs are underutilized resulting in substandard pruning practices.

KEYNOTE SPEAKERS

Dr. Edwin 'Win' Everham

Florida Gulf Coast University Fort Myers, FL

Edwin "Win" Everham, Ph.D. is an associate professor and Chair of the Division of Ecological and Social Sciences at Florida Gulf Coast University. He researches how ecosystems respond to disturbance events. These events include natural events like hurricanes, as well as ones caused by



humans such as the introduction of invasive species. He is currently exploring and tracking long-term growth in multiple forest plots including mangroves in the region toward quantifying carbon dynamics.

Jake Miesbauer, PhD is an Arboriculture Scientist at The Morton Arboretum in Lisle, IL. His research focuses on tree pruning, tree biomechanics, and tree risk management.
