- **FANJEAUX** - village where Dominic lived and where his spirit is very much alive
- **MONTSEGUR** - steep mountain refuge and last stronghold of the Cathars
- **PROUILHE** - first monastery of nuns founded by Dominic
- **SOREZE** - village where Lacordaire established an international school and where he is buried
- **TOULOUSE** - city where Dominic gathered his first friars

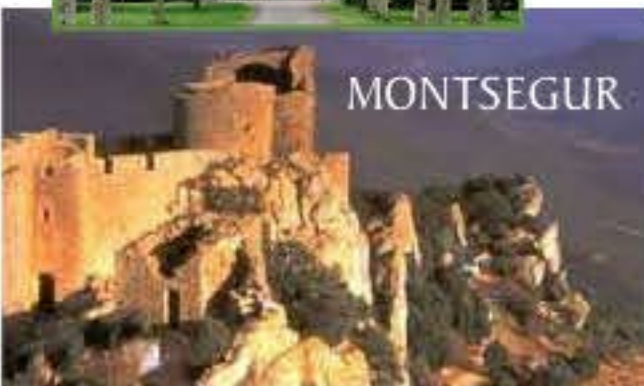
