Sr. Sheila Flynn, OP Dominican of East Australia & Solomon Islands

Sr. Sheila, recipient of the 2019 Fra Angelico Award, will be the 2023 Keynote Speaker. She holds a National Diploma in Fine Arts from the University of Johannesburg and her work has been exhibited across five continents: Asia, Europe, Australia, North America and Africa. Her art is inspiring and deeply thought provoking. In Matthew's Gospel we read, "The gift you have received, give as gift." Sheila has received multiple gifts and has willingly shared them with the world. She helped found and direct Kopanang (bringing together) which has empowered African women scourged by AIDS and HIV to create and share their art and use it to support their families. For these women Sheila has been a life raft in an ocean of need. Sheila currently ministers in Australia, This past August she was elected to her Congregations' Leadership Team.
