As such, there will be numerous activities that will coincide with our Golden Anniversary to mark this historic occasion.

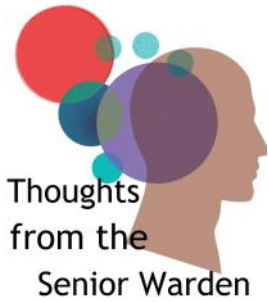
The Rt. Rev. Brian Cole, bishop of East Tennessee, will be our preacher and celebrant on Sunday, November 10th. The Singing Saints from ASES will join us that day and perform during the liturgy. Former rectors and clergy attached with All Saints' have all been invited to vest and be present at the altar. We will only have one service that day at 10:30 so that all of us can share in the worship and fellowship meal that is to follow. Please note that I made it a point to promise the 8:00 congregation that I will only cancel the early service once every 50 years.

We will have a number of adults and youth that will be presented for confirmations and receptions. In addition, there will be three baptisms as well. A time capsule that contains the history of All Saints' and numerous items donated for the future, will be blessed and dedicated by the bishop, and then buried in front of the church to be opened in the year 2069. There will be a luncheon following in the parish hall.

This is a wonderful historic day in the long life of All Saints' Episcopal Church in Morristown, TN. We have so much for which we are grateful and thankful. Please make every effort to be with us on November 9th and share in the celebration. Try and get here early that morning. We do expect a full congregation that day.

GROUNDS COMMITTEE: Refurbishment of our sign has begun! We gratefully appreciate those who have made a donation in support of this work. My report is that we are doing the job set out by that opening scripture. Please understand that good works are, well, good! But the rewards of Christian Discipleship have eternal, not temporal, meaning.

I encourage everyone to participate in as many of these programs as you are able. It is an exciting time to be a Christian at All Saints'.

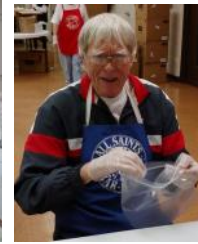

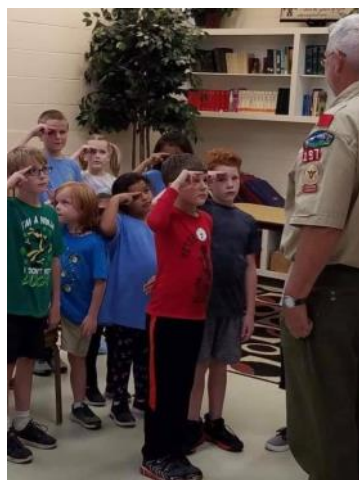


DOC'S SCOUT NEWS

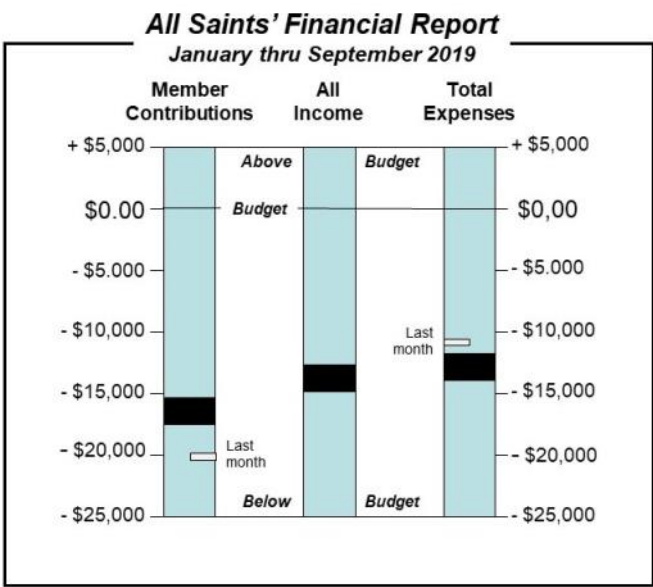
