

GIVING SOMETHING UP OR TAKING SOMETHING ON FOR LENT

Lent is right around the corner. In Louisiana the Carnival Parades are rolling down the street fast and furious as Mardi Gras approaches. This year Ash Wednesday falls on March 6th. So now is the time to choose what discipline will be mine for the upcoming 40 days of Lent.

Of course there are always the traditional sacrifices of fasting, alms giving, and prayer. Some people will give up alcohol, others will give up chocolate, or red meat. These are all versions of fasting disciplines. There are also the giving of alms associated with Lent. Do you have a favorite charity or non-profit that you support, then by all means, give to them. Finally, there are the prayer disciplines that are commended during Lent. Pray for those who are sick. Pray for those who are spiritually lost. Offer prayers of thanksgiving for your many blessings. You can even pray for your enemies. While you are at it, pray for that crazy relative who knows just how to push your button and knows exactly how to find a way to step on your last nerve.

Fasting, alms giving, and prayer, have all long been part of Lent. Though this year, how about doing something more simple and basic for Lent? What about doing something that might be habit forming in our lives? Here is what I'm suggesting for Lent 2019. Just go to church. Really make it a priority. Forget about hitting the snooze button and sleeping in on Sunday. Get up and go to church. Sunday is the first day of the week so start your week off right by going to church. Lent is only six weeks long. Go all in. Try committing yourself to going to church for six straight weeks.

Maybe you will be traveling out of town and it will take you away from All Saints'. No problem, then go visit a church that is out of town. Bring me back the church bulletin for that day. I love to see what other churches are doing. Commit to the entire season of Lent and go to church. After six straight weeks, you will have conditioned your body and soul to a new way of living. You will have created a new normal in your life.

Lent is all about repenting and returning. It's about getting your life back on track once again. It's about getting rid of old negative habits and forming new positive ones. Think about it. Six weeks gives you a chance to create a new way of thinking about church. Six weeks allows you to focus on the spiritual health of your soul. Lent is an opportunity to hit the reset button in your life. It's a grand do-over.

Fast if you feel called to do so. Give if you feel generous. Pray for yourself and others. Without a personal connection to a faith community it is difficult to connect these three Lenten disciplines to a new way of living. This year, come to Church for Lent.
