Preamble	The "Combined Clubs Standard Instructions", for Handicap, is to be read with, and forms part of, this Notice of Race.					
Invitation	The Organising Authority and the Host Club - The Royal Hamilton Amateur Dinghy Club (R.H.A.D.C.), are pleased to invite sailors to compete in the R.H.A.D.C. Anniversary Regatta.					
1.	RULES					
1.1	The regattas will be governed by "rules" as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).					
2.	ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY					
2.1	The regatta is open to keelboats and yachts. Proof of insurance, to comply with SI 29.1, will be required prior to registration being accepted. All boats will race in the PHRF class.					
	Registration will be by delivering a completed entry form, and the registration fee, to the Sailing Office.					
3.	SCHEDULE					
3.1	Registration will be no later than the day before competing in the regatta.					
3.2	The regatta schedule will be as indicated in "Addendum 2 –Schedule". One race will be scheduled for the regatta.					
3.3	The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1030 hours on the scheduled race day. No warning signal will be made after 1230 hours.					
3.4	Races Abandoned or Postponed will be started as soon as practicable.					
3.5	Races not sailed on the scheduled race day will not be rescheduled and will be scored as void.					
4.	RACING AREAS					
4.1	The starting area will be in Hamilton Harbour.

6.	SCORING					
6.1	Scoring will be based on corrected time using time-on-time scoring and PHRF handicaps.					
6.2	The Low Poi	The Low Point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply with no scores excluded.				
	Boats will be allocated to divisions and classes by the R/C, based on their handicap, boat type, sail plan, and the number of entries,					
6.3	all boats will be entered into the Overall Division.					
	In addition classes will be scored. Classes will be comprised of:					
	 One-design boats, with three or more entrants. The scoring will be based on their finishing order. 					
	 PHRF class fleet for all other keelboats. The scoring will be based on their corrected time using their PHRF handicaps. 					
6.4	Prizes will be awarded to the first three boats in the Overall, and the first boat in each class/division.
