The minimum criteria for the graduate scholarship selection are as follows:

- a. Open to women
- b. GPA of 3.0 or higher
- c. Currently enrolled in a transportation-related graduate degree program, such as transportation engineering, construction management, planning, finance, or logistics
- d. Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field

The scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation study goals, academic records, and transportation-related activities or job skills. Minority candidates are encouraged to apply.

Copies or original transcripts sent from students will not be accepted. An electronic official transcript from your school is highly desirable. If your school is not able to send an electronic transcript, a version sent via mail will be accepted.
