On March 07, 2019 Uranus moved into the sign of Taurus where it will stay until April 26, 2026. You are receiving my newsletter when the planet Venus is in conjunction with Uranus in Taurus. Uranus in the planet that is and will be the ruler of the Age of Aquarius for the next 2,000 years. Feels pretty important, doesn't it? Now the planet Saturn is in Aquarius, adding its wisdom, structure, organization and good father energy to aid us in becoming the cosmic adults we need to be. My personal favorite Stoic, Epictetus wrote the following, 300 years before the birth of Christ and the beginning of the Age of Pisces. I believe he was one of the first Aquarian philosophers.

"One cannot pursue one's highest good without, at the same time, promoting the good of others. Our human contract is not with the few people with who our affairs are most immediately intertwined, nor the prominent, rich or well educated, but to all of our human brethren. Believing spirit does in fact imbue matter and is expressed through the earth, Uranus will create innovations in cooking, art, and technology. You could have a unique, inventive approach to

financial matters in the investment fields as well as banking and real estate. The Uranus hurricane could create disruptions in our financial life in order to promote the freedom that comes from releasing tangible possessions. Uranus is the planet of change and Taurus rules our personal values and finances. We will experience many changes and shifts in these areas in the coming years. No more false, inauthentic values. Uranus in Taurus will set us free from imposed values and meanings. If our foundations are based on external security, Uranus' winds will bring the necessary changes to promote more internal confidence and peace.
