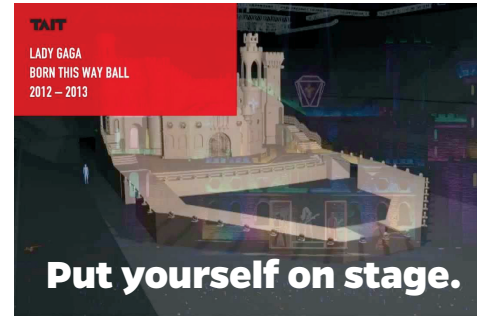
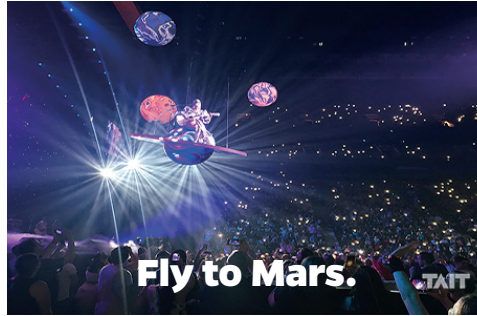


Manufacturing Technician Pre-Apprenticeship Program
