("Harm"). I AGREE to hold harmless and release the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm of any nature caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm arises or results, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of the Competition. **General Information:**

1. Competition will be limited to a total of 30 entries. Entries will not be accepted without payment
2. Competition will begin promptly at 3:00pm on Tuesday, June 4<sup>th</sup> beginning with the 3 year olds
3. Each horse will be given a scheduled jump time
4. Each horse will be allowed approximately 5 minutes to warm up in a round pen before entering the indoor if needed
5. Once horse has entered the ring, it will be handled by an appointed handler
6. The horse will be presented to the judges and then walked through the chute
7. Each horse will have 2 times through the chute before being judged
8. Each horse will be judged on 4 times through the chute

**Exhibitor's party will be held immediately following competition****Jump Chute:**

1. The jump chute will consist of a vertical one stride to a vertical or oxer (depending on the stride of the horse) then one stride to an Oxer
2. Final jump for 3 year olds not to exceed 1.15m
3. Final jump for 4 year olds not to exceed 1.30m
4. Horses will be judged as individuals, it is up to the judges to decide jump heights with the horse's best interest in mind.

**Scoring:**

1. The panel will consist of 3 judges who will give scores in each of 3 categories; Technique, scope and type (this takes into consideration the horse's general conformation, canter stride, carefulness and character)
2. Final scores will be the average combined score from each judge
3. Bridle and front boots are required
4. We recommend horses be braided and groomed for competition

**Prizes:**

1. Prizes for each age group will be awarded as follows:  
Champion \$350  
Reserve Champion \$100  
3<sup>rd</sup> place \$50
2. Ribbons through 6<sup>th</sup> place
