## **How to Get Involved at CCHS**

## 1. Sign up to volunteer (this is the best way to meet other CCHS parents).

- go to <u>www.cathedralcatholic.org</u>
- click on the "Parents" tab, then "Parent Association" under "Content"
- click on "Volunteer Opportunities" link
- volunteer opportunities will be posted here throughout the year
- sign up for the event and day/time that works best for your schedule

## 2. Attend Parent Association meetings.

These meetings are held in the faculty lounge (\*with the exception of the first meeting of the year,, which is held in the Academic Center) at 6:30 p.m. on the first Tuesday of the following months: September, October, November, February, March and April. Principal Kevin Calkins and President Steve Laaperi give regular updates at these meetings as to what's going on at CCHS. Parent Association committee chairpersons also give updates on committee activities. Everyone is welcome to attend.

If you would like to become involved on a more regular basis, there are some Parent Association committees that need regular committee members. These committees will meet throughout the year and plan several activities. To find out what committee opportunities are available, attend the first Parent Association meeting in September or check the Parent Association page under the "Parents" tab on the CCHS website. (Note: The Parent Association page on the CCHS website may be under construction so may not be available until after the school year begins). ## 3. Attend weekly Parents in Prayer sessions on campus

A small group of parents gather each Tuesday morning at 8 a.m. in the chapel to pray for our students, families, and school community. See the information for Parents in Prayer on the CCHS website under the "Parents" tab.

4. If your child is involved in a sport or drama or other activity on campus, get involved with those groups. Coordinate a team potluck on campus before or after a game/event, offer to drive players to a game, keep score or work behind the scenes at a production.

- 5. **Become involved in the Dons Athletic Club**. The Dons Club is the athletic fundraising arm of the athletic department. All Dons families are members, but Premium Fan Packages are available for home football and basketball games.
