CCS's Summer Camp Under the Oaks Health Procedures

Updated May 20, 2020

**With summer rapidly approaching, we are pleased to announce that Summer Camp Under the Oaks is set to begin on June 8th!**

In order for our staff to maintain a safe space for all campers there are a few new precautions being put in place:

- In an effort to eliminate the amount of “through traffic”, we will be implementing new drop off and pick up procedures.
  - **Upon arrival, an employee will stand outside the Upper School building and greet parents and campers. Campers will have their temperature taken by a no-touch forehead thermometer.** If a child has a temperature of 100.1 or shows any symptoms of shortness of breath or a productive cough, they will be asked to go home.
  - **During dismissal, please wait outside the Upper School building, staff will use walkie talkies to call for each child. Employees will escort your children outside.**
- As suggested by the CDC, **campers will remain in the same small group throughout the week. There will be no more than ten campers per group.**
- While moving around campus, **campers and employees will be required to sanitize their hands before entering each room.** Employees will also sanitize supplies and thoroughly disinfect each room before a new group of campers may enter.
- **We will have all the necessary cleaning supplies, as well as a dedicated maintenance staff that will meticulously clean at the end of each day.**
- **If a child becomes sick during camp, he/she will be kept comfortable in a designated room until a parent/guardian can pick up.** We will need parent cooperation in helping us make sure that symptomatic children are kept home until a **full 24 hours** after symptoms have cleared. If your child is given any fever-reducing medication in the morning before arriving, please be sure to let the camp counselors know. We also ask for clear communication if parents become aware of possible exposure to any illness, especially COVID-19.

**While trying to return to a sense of normality, please understand that the safety of the children and employees is of utmost concern.** We thank you in advance for your patience and flexibility with us as we navigate through the summer months. It is our goal to maintain a safe environment while the children learn and have fun. We are excited to host your child/children this year at Summer Under the Oaks!
