Grace Episcopal Church of Saint Helena and its affiliates (collectively, “Grace Episcopal Church”) are committed to respecting the privacy of individuals who visit our website. We do use some information you provide in order to make your experience on our website better, but we recognize that this information belongs to you and we take your privacy very seriously. Unless specified otherwise, Grace Episcopal Church will adhere to the privacy policy detailed in this statement.

Application of Privacy Policy

This privacy policy applies to all personal information submitted by Users through Grace Episcopal Church’s website (the “website”), Constant Contact, and Realm.

Personal Information

Grace Episcopal Church collects personal and non-personal information from our online users. This information is used only for internal purposes and is not disclosed to any non-affiliated third parties.

Personal information, such as name, address, and contact information, is collected so Grace Episcopal Church can contact you. We may collect this information and other personal information when you wish to obtain goods or services from us, when you register for communications, events, and when you participate in activities or complete other forms. Grace Episcopal Church will not collect any personal information about visitors except when they knowingly provide it, and this information will be kept confidential and will not be disclosed to non-affiliated third parties except when required by law.

Grace Episcopal Church takes precautions – including administrative, technical, and physical measures – to safeguard your personal information against loss, theft, and misuse, as well as against unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration, and destruction. Because the internet is not a secure medium, the privacy of communications over the internet cannot be guaranteed. Grace Episcopal Church does not assume responsibility (and, in fact, specifically disclaims responsibility) for any harm, loss, or damage you may incur by the sending of personal or confidential information over the internet by or to Grace Episcopal Church.

Use of Information and Data

We use the information you provide for the purposes for which it was originally collected, for example, to respond to your email or to provide the programs or services you requested. We may also use this information to help us improve the content and functionality of our website, to better understand the needs and interests of the people and organizations that use our website, and to improve our programs and services. Grace Episcopal Church may use Google Analytics to help us gather details about the use of our websites. Google Analytics is a web analytics tool that helps website owners understand how visitors engage with their sites. Google Analytics collects information anonymously.
