Naloxone Training at the Dignity Center
July 19, 12-2pm

Back in March our Confirmation class began brainstorming ways that HAUMC could help address the opioid crisis. One of our students shared what he had learned about Naloxone and how it is used to reverse an overdose and save lives. Their conversations have resulted in a partnership with the Steve Remler Hope Network, who will be joining us at the Dignity Center on July 19 to conduct training on how to effectively and safely use Naloxone. They will also be supplying the Dignity Center with Naloxone, making it an official Naloxone Access Point in Minnesota. This training event is open to everyone!
