SUMMARY



As students and teachers continue to adjust to the more rigorous TNReady standards, we're beginning to see encouraging progress in multiple areas. While there is little movement in the total percentage of high school students rated at the highest achievement levels, more students District-wide are moving out of the lowest achievement category in the majority of subjects. At the school level, many high schools are showing improvement on both ends of the spectrum, including several high-performers that continue to outpace statewide scores in the highest achievement categories. Additionally, all student subgroups are improving across the majority of subjects.

DISTRICT-WIDE EOC SCORES

MATH: 20 of 41 high schools increased the percentage of students rated On-Track/Mastered; 21 decreased the percentage rated Below



The percentage of Algebra I students rated On-Track/Mastered increased nearly 2 points; the percentage of students rated Below decreased by over 4 points

ENGLISH: 17 of 41 high schools increased the percentage of students rated On-Track/Mastered; 40 decreased the percentage rated Below



The percentage of students rated Below fell 9.9 points in English I, 7.1 in English II and 12.6 in English III; the percentage of students rated On-Track/Mastered increased nearly 5 points in English III
