## 2019-20 ACT TEACHER FACILITATOR ROLE DESCRIPTION

### Purpose

Per the ACT Playbook, it is recommended that all 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students attend quarterly ACT workshops. As such, we will need high school teachers to facilitate these Saturday sessions. The ACT Teacher Facilitator is considered a teacher-leader who provides ACT content and strategies to 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students in the areas of English/Reading or Math/Science. The position includes a stipend of \$500 per semester (\$1,000 for school year 2019-20).

### Requirements

- Demonstrate knowledge of the ACT College and Career Readiness Standards (English, Reading, Math and/or Science)
- Facilitate Saturday ACT sessions for district ninth and tenth grade students (including, but not limited to set-up and dismissal)
  - Two 3-hr sessions each Saturday (English/Reading or Math/Science)
- Attend **all** facilitator preparation trainings (once in July and once in January)

### Eligibility

- Composite TEM 3, 4, or 5
- Demonstrate effective communication skills
- Valid Tennessee teaching license
- Current high school teacher

### Additional Information

- The stipend will be paid in two installments – once in December 2019 and once in May 2020. **All requirements must be met prior to payment each semester.**
- The dates for ACT Workshop sessions:
  - Saturday, September 7, 2019
  - Saturday, November 23, 2019
  - Saturday, February 1, 2020
  - Saturday, March 28, 2020
- Facilitators are required to attend **one** of the following preparation trainings **each semester.**
  - Preparation for Fall sessions
    - English/Reading Facilitator – July 17 or July 24
    - Math/Science Facilitator – July 18 or July 25
  - Preparation for Spring sessions
    - English/Reading Facilitator – January 11 or January 25
    - Math/Science Facilitator – January 11 or January 25
