Overview	Support provides up to 3 months of access to an online study guide with 240 Tutoring at no cost to SCS employees. 240 Tutoring provides a diagnostic test, flashcards, presentation of content, quizzes, and practice tests.	Support is led by current SCS employees who've recently passed the Praxis exam and will assist attendees in identifying effective study strategies and resources specific to the exam.	Support is provided through Public Consulting Group and offers a 12-week intensive study program based on individual diagnostic results. Studying includes 1:1 sessions and small group sessions.
