2. **March 6**—Hospitality and unity in Radnor, Wayne, and other local communities. Guest presenter: The Rev. Howard Childs, Jr., Second Baptist Church, Wayne.
3. **March 13**—Share stories of hospitality throughout the Episcopal Diocese of Pennsylvania.
4. **March 20**—Explore ways we can each grow to "seek and serve Christ in all persons" and "strive for justice and peace among all people, and respect the dignity of every human being." This is a chance for you to share your hospitality ministries, and invite others in the wider community to join you!

The focus will be on the many ways we are called to be hospitable and "Love your neighbor as yourself." Each of us has meaningful experiences to share.
