A Successful Season

As we flip the athletic calendar from the conclusion of fall sports to the start of winter sports, we look back at the successful season we had at Central High School. A few highlights include:



Both the boys and girls volleyball teams participated in the WIAA Sectional Final. During the regular season the girl's team split with Burlington to share the Southern Lakes Conference Championship. However, in the postseason Burlington was able to withstand a valiant effort by the Lady Falcons. Burlington went on to win the Division I WIAA State Championship. Despite the boys being the fourth seed heading into the WIAA Tournament, the team turned a number heads by defeating #1 seed and 4th ranked Muskego in an epic five set match. This propelled the team into the Sectional Final where the team lost to a very talented and experienced Franklin squad.

The Badger Co-op Swim Team was the WIAA Sectional Runner-up with a team score of 299.5. The team fell just short of champion Greenfield who had a team score of 313. Representing Central during the WIAA Sectional were Claire Koeppel and Eden Wember. Koeppel won the 200 Yard Freestyle and 500 Yard Freestyle. Her time in the 500 was 5:22.07 and her time in the 200 was 1:59.38. At the WIAA State Meet she had a time of 2:00.26 in the 200 and 5:22.21 in the 500. Wember finished sixth at the Sectional in the 200 Yard IM with a time of 2:22.18 and fifth in the 100 Yard Butterfly with a time of 1:02.39





This year's varsity cross country team featured a number of outstanding individual performances. Junior Heaven Anderson leads the pack by qualifying for the WIAA State Meet in Wisconsin Rapids. This year Heaven finished second at the Southern Lakes Conference Meet with a time of 20:02.28, she finished third at the WIAA Sectional with a time of 19:43 and finished 45th at the WIAA State Meet with a time of 19:46. This year's breakout performance on the boys side was Will Allen who finished fifth at the Southern Lakes All-Conference Meet with a time of 17:32 and finished eighth at the WIAA Sectional with a time of 17:19, missing the WIAA State Meet by only one spot.

The girls tennis team finished second in the Southern Lakes Conference, only dropping their match against Badger. Additionally, the team won the WIAA Subsectional hosted by Kenosha Tremper. Winning their matches to qualify for the WIAA Sectional were Janell Gillmore in Singles Flight 1, Sara Backus and Bojana Bojanic in Doubles Flight 1, Kenna Beth and Emily Wermeling in Doubles Flight 2, and Paige Wysiatko and Tommie Capelli in Doubles Flight 3.
