### TWO SOCIETY MEETINGS: MARCH 3 + MAY 20

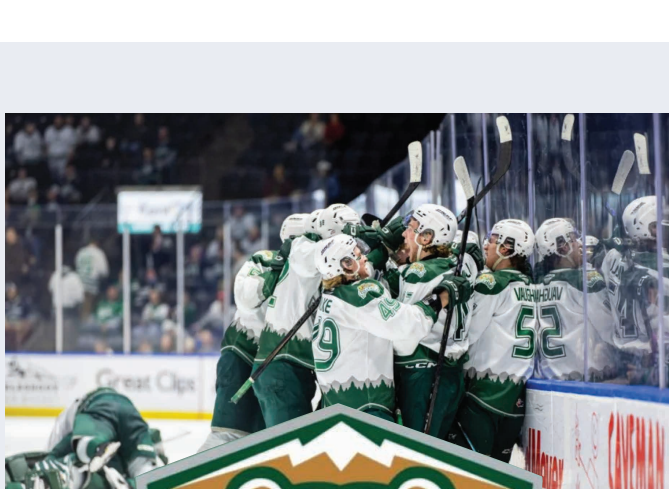
