

Bowhunting NYC Watershed Lands

Bow-Only Units

Bow-only areas are easily accessible throughout the NYC watershed lands. East of the Hudson, you may want to check out the nearly 300 acre [Turkey Mountain West unit](#). This recreation area is located just north of the Croton Reservoir and right off the Taconic Parkway. The property is mostly wooded and provides for great deer hunting and, as the name suggests, turkey hunting opportunities. Also, don't forget to check out the nearby 100 acre [Turkey Mountain East unit](#).

West of the Hudson, you may be interested in bowhunting around the Ashokan Reservoir in Ulster County. Ample bow-only opportunities exist in this area, but one of the largest tracts is the 500 acre [Glenford Unit](#). This recreation area stretches across the northern shoreline of the eastern end of the reservoir. One of the most attractive features of this property is its location. Hunters will find ample parking and access trails along NY28.
