

# IT IS EASY BEING GREEN!




**You can help us make the difference!**

As we have always said, our sustainability efforts flourish because of the dedicated efforts of our team members. **Please, take the time to follow the directions on the various dumpsters/crushers on the loading dock and in other locations around the property.** Trash and Recycling are clearly labeled, as is the adjacent Cardboard crusher on the loading dock. It's not always easy—sometimes this is a multi-step process (for example, if Styrofoam is in boxes, the Styrofoam goes into the trash and the cardboard goes into the crusher). If you have questions, ask a team member for assistance. Only with your help can our environmental efforts be successful!

» Have you noticed the soap in Seaport's plaza level herb garden? If you recall, last spring & summer, we had many four-legged (bunny!) visitors. This year, the soap was placed in the garden as an all-natural deterrent.
