<p>RESTAURANTS & FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ May allow bar-top seating with appropriate social distancing ✓ May operate up to 50% indoor capacity ✓ City of Sanibel has issued authorization for additional outdoor seating 	<p>CITY OF SANIBEL RECREATION CENTER</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Phase 1 Re-Opening & Youth Summer Camp will open June 15th (Details Forthcoming)
<p>RETAIL</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ May operate at full capacity with responsible social distancing and sanitization protocols ✓ May temporarily display merchandise outdoors until Labor Day 	<p>BEACHES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Lifted all COVID-19 related restrictions at all City owned & operated parking lots ✓ Temporarily prohibited possession & consumption of alcoholic beverages from 7am to 5pm at all City operated beaches and associated parks and picnic areas with paid public parking (i.e., Bowman's Beach, Blind Pass, Tarpon Bay Beach, Gulfside City Park (Algiers), Lighthouse Beach and Fishing Pier, and Trost Parking Lot), as well as the beach area at the northern terminus of Bailey Beach Road, and the picnic areas at the Sanibel Boat Ramp, through Labor Day ✓ Through Labor Day consumption or possession of alcohol on all City operated beaches & associated parks and picnic areas with paid public parking, by groups of 10 or more persons require a City of Sanibel Special Event Permit

<p>MUSEUMS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ May operate up to 50% capacity indoors ✓ Check directly with the museum for current operations 	
<p>PRIVATE FITNESS CENTERS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ May operate at full capacity with responsible social distancing and frequent sanitization protocols 	<p>SANIBEL PUBLIC LIBRARY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ See www.sanilib.org for Phase 1 Opening
<p>PERSONAL SERVICES BUSINESSES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Barber shops, hair salons, tanning salons & nail salons may operate while adhering to guidance from the FL Department of Health 	<p>ENTERTAINMENT BUSINESSES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Including but not limited to movie theaters, concert houses, auditoriums and playhouses may operate at 50% capacity with appropriate social distancing and sanitization protocols.
