# SPEAKER

**Brenna Rheinhart was born and raised on Sanibel Island, Florida. She attended Vanderbilt University, where she joined the Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ROTC) and was commissioned as an Ensign in the United States Navy. After earning her wings of gold as a Naval Flight Officer, Brenna joined the VQ-1 "World Watchers," serving as Mission Commander and Senior Evaluator aboard the EP-3 Orion from 2014 to 2017. During this time, she completed detachments to Qatar, Greece, Italy, Japan, the Philippines, and Guam. In 2017, Brenna transitioned to a shore tour as the Training Department Head at the Survival, Evasion, Resistance, and Escape (SERE) schoolhouse in Coronado, California. In this role she oversaw the delivery of high-risk training to over 4,100 Joint Force personnel. She separated from active duty in 2021 and joined the United States Navy Reserves, currently serving as the Manpower Department Head at the Volunteer Training Unit in San Diego. Her personal decorations include Air Medal, Air Medal - Strike/Flight, and the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal. In her civilian career, Brenna is the Talent Development Manager for the Americas at Teleflex, a global provider of medical technologies, where she oversees the learning and development of over 7,000 employees across the region. Brenna is married to Lieutenant Colonel Erik Rheinhart, USMC, from Bettendorf, Iowa, and together they are proud parents of their four-year-old daughter, Azalia.**
