



YOUNG HORSE DEWORMING PROTOCOL

FOAL DEWORMING PROTOCOL

MONTH	DEWORMER
MAY/JUNE (1 month of age)	Double dose Fenbendazole
JULY/AUGUST (3 months of age)	Double dose Fenbendazole
SEPTEMBER/OCTOBER (5 months of age, just prior to weaning)	FEC Double dose Fenbedazole or Ivermectin or Pyrantel Pamoate pending outcome of FEC
NOVEMBER	Ivermectin/Praziquantel

FEC = FECAL EGG COUNT

Note 1: Weight tapes should be used to calculate appropriate dosages for foals. Please consult your veterinarian if you need assistance.

Note 2: If your foal is born early in the season, an additional deworming may be added prior to weaning.

YEARLING AND TWO YEAR OLD DEWORMING PROTOCOL
