

# FY2020 CITY MANAGER'S PROPOSED BUDGET

## MESSAGE FROM THE CITY MANAGER

I am excited to share the Annual Budget for the City of Largo for Fiscal Year 2020. This budget has been developed through immense teamwork, participation and dedication of team members at all levels, in all departments. The total Citywide expenditures are \$167,699,700 for all funds and include a total of 948.13 FTE (positions), including \$82,757,200 in the General Fund.

Our organization continues to focus on building progress and momentum around the strategic goals and vision established by the City Commission. By staying disciplined in our commitment to these goals, this budget will continue that forward progress. The 2020 Proposed Budget includes continued investment in community infrastructure, from roads to sewer system improvements to stormwater repairs. It includes early steps to start the development of a new, mixed-use City Hall in downtown Largo. FY 2020 will represent Largo Central Park's 25th Anniversary, and will include a worthy celebration of the park that is a centerpiece of our community. We continue to invest in emergency management preparedness, and will maintain our commitment to public safety with additional Firefighter/Paramedics and Fire Rescue Lieutenants in 2020.

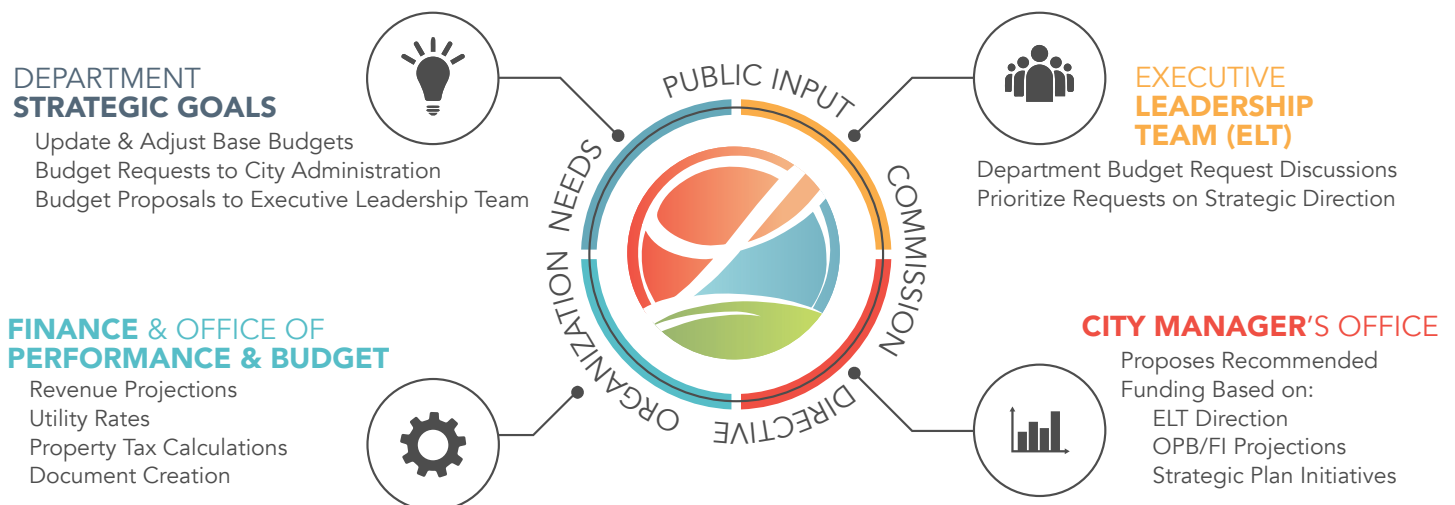


The FY 2019 budget made substantial investment towards community goals. I am proud to list just a few accomplishments from this year: Continued progress toward enhancing the look, feel and function of our community by developing the City of Largo's downtown "brand" and identity; installing new way-finding signs at Largo Central Park; and working toward the award of construction for the West Bay Drive Pinellas Trailhead project and "triangle" gateway plaza at West Bay Drive and Seminole/Missouri. The Bookmobile began making stops around the community, bringing Library service to new populations. We also conducted High Performance Organization training for dozens of our City team members and developed an on-going training to sustain the continuous improvement opportunities for our entire organization, which is intend to continually enhance our superior service delivery to our community. These successes, and our continued progress, will help us realize our Vision of becoming the Community of Choice in Tampa Bay.

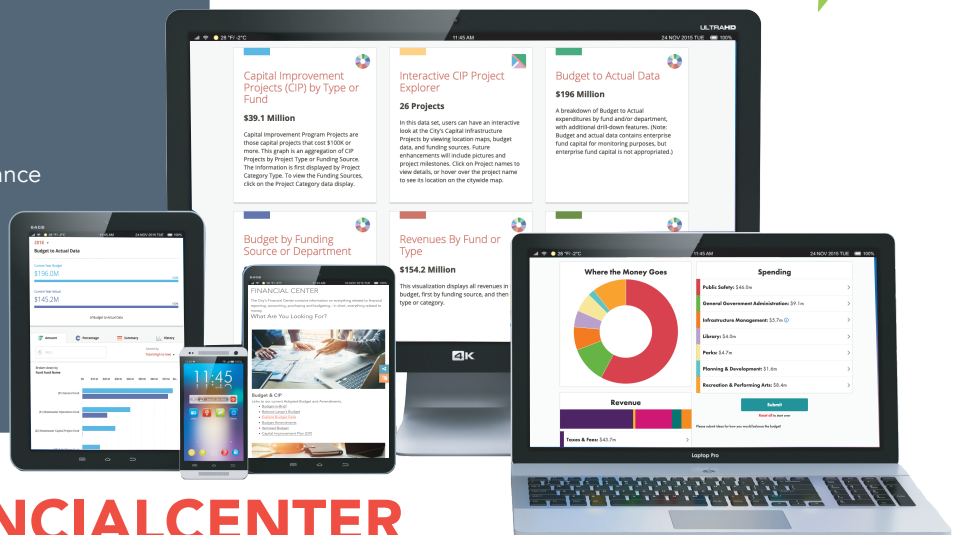
