FRIENDSHIP, A107:

An intergenerational class made up of singles and couples! We join together to study through open discussion and lectures around the Bible.

GOOD SAMARITAN, Youth Building: **NEW**

A group focused on reading and discussing books that relate to the society around us and how God is at work in our lives and community. This is a group that cultivates dialogue and creates space to gracefully and lovingly agree and disagree with one another. .

INNKEEPER, Youth Building: **NEW**

A discussion group focused on digging deeper into the Word. Utilizing short term Disciple Bible Studies curriculum, we look each week at what Scripture says and how Scripture inspires us to love our neighbors.

JOURNEY, A105:

Open to all ages we are a group that gathers for Bible study and theological discussions. We are a group of mission-minded individuals and grow together through studies such as Drive Through History videos and series on the Holy Land as well as learning about the spread of Christianity.

OPEN FORUM, B201:

Open Forum is comprised of both married and single adults from age of 50+. This class is offered in person and online through Zoom. We enjoy open discussions on various Bible and book studies facilitated by rotating class members.

PEACH, B211:

A group of parents, both married and single with children typically in elementary and middle school. The class utilizes scripture video studies as well as book studies that help us to live out our faith daily and grow in our relationship with Christ. We rotate facilitators so that new voices and perspectives can be heard. Service is our faith in action so we partner locally throughout the year to serve our community here in Smyrna. If you are looking to build community, share life experiences, serve together and grow in your faith - we welcome you to join us!

ROLAND WALKER/DAVID JONES, B205:

A hybrid class offered both in-person and online through zoom. We are comprised of couples and single adults ranging anywhere from 50 and up. When you are in this class, we consider you family.

SHARING, A207:

This Class that has been in existence for more than fifty years. At this point most of the Class members are in their mature years, although the Class is welcome to all.

It is a "Caring" Class that begins every session with prayer requests and praises. The focus is on Bible Study, mixed with a variety of speakers talking about a variety of topics. Many of the members play leadership roles in the Church, and many volunteer in a number of Church Programs.
