When the Tillman House resource center opened its doors in 2018, it made a conscious decision to put a priority on building relationships with those in the community who are in need OF HELP and those who need TO HELP.

Tillman House is committed to:

- Help individuals who are in an emergency financial situation for basic needs such as rent or utility assistance due to job loss, illness or other unforeseen circumstances. Through our partnerships, we can offer guidance to various resources.
- Supply Cobb families several resources such as Food Boxes, Diapers, Wipes, and basic Hygiene Necessities Programs. The Tillman House is also able to assist families in need with school uniforms and supplies.
- Provide a safe place for several support and counseling groups to meet: AA, NA, Al-Anon, Caregivers Support Group are included.
- Offer Free Adult Education Classes. In partnership with the Cliff Jordan Education Center, we seek to provide members of our community with practical tools for personal growth and development through free classes and programs designed to stimulate learning and instill independence.
- Provide an After School Program for 1st through 3rd grade. Children will be offered mentoring, coaching, accountability and targeted learning tailored to the needs of the individual, regardless of age.
- Offer the "Table At Tillman", also known as Dinner Church, a worship service with a meal for those who may not have ever been to church, might have had a bad experience at church, or can't get to church on a Sunday morning. This service is every third Saturday of the month at 5 pm!
