BIBLICAL CONNECTIONS, B210:

A smaller gathering of those looking to walk through the Bible together while discussing how it connects to our daily walk with Christ.

FRIENDSHIP, A107:

The friendship class is made up of a range of ages, typically running from 50 years old and up. We are a group of single and married adults who join together to study through open discussion and lectures around the Bible.

GOOD SAMARITAN, Youth Building: NEW

The first study for this class will be Andy Stanley's book: *Not In It To Win It*. Begins August 14th.

INNKEEPER, Youth Building: NEW

The first focus of study for this class will be the Gospel of John, walking weekly through the Gospel text. Begins August 14th.

JOURNEY, A105:

Open to all ages we are a group that gathers for Bible study and theological discussions. We are a group of mission-minded individuals and grow together through studies such as Drive Through History videos and series on the Holy Land as well as learning about the spread of Christianity.

OPEN FORUM, B201:

Open Forum is comprised of both married and single adults. Most of us are 60+, with most of us retired. However, we would love to welcome some "younger blood to our class!"

PEACH, B211:

A gathering of adults whose kids are in elementary and middle school. We typically utilize Right Now Media for our lessons, which cover various lessons on the Bible and on Christian living. We focus on faith, family and fellowship.

ROLAND WALKER/DAVID JONES, B205:

A hybrid class offered both in-person and online through zoom. We are comprised of couples and single adults ranging anywhere from 50 and up. The class is led by a rotation of retired clergy.

SHARING CLASS, A207:

This class is made up of singles and couples, ranging from the age of 50-something to 80-something! Everyone of every age is welcome to join us. We are actively involved in many aspects of the church and are mission oriented.

Our lessons consist of class members and other members of the church and outside guests teaching and sharing, Bible study sessions, and video based sessions with discussion.

TRINITY SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASS, A102:

An adult class of a blend of ages, stages and marital status. Our class has a heart for volunteering in many areas of the Church. The Bible based curriculum is class selected and led by various members. Whether you are new to the community or been a long time member of Smyrna First, you are welcome.

YOUNG ADULTS CLASS, C211:

This class is for young couples and singles, to gather together cultivating community, walking through life and studying scripture.
