Food Chains Wed., Oct. 20 at 4:00 pm EST (discussion on Zoom)

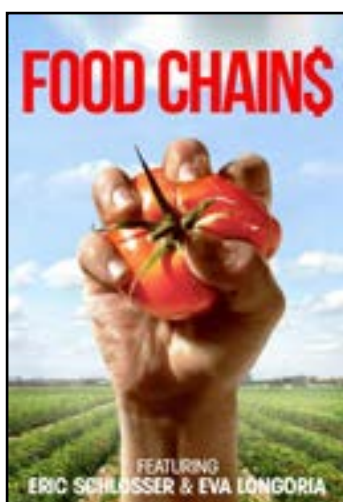
