

2022 Boar's Head Indoor Golf League

Rules Sheet

- Game – Points Quota
 - Each hole is worth an amount of points based on the score you hole out with. Double bogey is max.
 - Eagle – 4 points
 - Birdie – 3 points
 - Par – 2 points
 - Bogey – 1 pt.
 - Double Bogey++ = 0 points
 - Based on your USGA Index and Course handicap for the course being played that week you will receive a quota or goal of points for the round
 - Ex. If you have a USGA course handicap of 16 then your point's quota for the day will be 20 points (36 points is par or baseline). How many points you get relative to 18 will give you a (+/-) for the day. If your quota is 16 and you get 20 points then you are +4 for the day
 - We will use your current USGA index and tee played to determine your quota for that tournament
- Tees
 - We will have 2 different tee options
 - 55 and over will play at about 5800 yards
 - 54 and under will play at about 6300 yards
 - Note – each will change depending on the course but will be as close to these yardages as possible
 - Players 55 and older can choose which tee they would like to play
- Putting
 - Auto Tour Professional Putting
 - Will automatically putt out for you once the ball comes to rest on the putting surface. The software acts like you are an average PGA Tour professional on the greens and will determine the outcome based on percentages of make/miss and 3 putt percentages from each distance.
 - Example – PGA Tour pros from 20 feet 1 putt 15% of the time, 3 putt 2.2% of the time, and 2 putt about 82% of the time
- \$30 per round total per person
 - \$10 will go to the competition
 - \$7 will go to individual money pot for that specific competition and \$3 will go to the overall best score relative to quota for the 4 competitions
 - \$20 will be cost of simulator/host pro
 - Each participant's member account will be charged and winnings will be received in golf shop gift card
