The 2025 Immunization Champion Award is hosted by the Association of Immunization Managers (AIM) and funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). **This national award program recognizes an Immunization Champion from each of the 64 federally funded immunization programs.** Nominees are chosen for their commitment to going above and beyond to promote or foster adult and childhood immunizations in their communities.

How it Works

Visit AIM's Immunization Champion Award web page to get started! Here you can review eligibility requirements and download the nomination form. All nominations should be submitted to the immunization program for the state/territory where the nominee resides. Immunization programs submit their selected Champion to AIM, who does a final review and then sends award plaques to the 2025 Immunization Champions. The awardees are announced during National Immunization Awareness Month in August.

Timeline

- **March:** Immunization Champion Award webpage launches
- **June:** Immunization programs send their selected Champion to AIM
- **August:** AIM announces the 64 Immunization Champions
