**Childhood immunization schedules are going digital!**

Unfortunately, printed, laminated childhood immunization schedules will no longer be available in Washington. We know how valuable this resource is, but these days, there are many other ways to get schedules quickly and conveniently. You can still even keep it in your pocket via an app!

Here's a quick rundown of how you can get the childhood immunization schedule.

## Forecast it!

Use the Washington Immunization Information System (WA IIS) to quickly see what vaccines each patient is due for. No schedule needed!

1. Log in to the IIS: [www.waiis.wa.gov](http://www.waiis.wa.gov)
2. Bring up the patient's record
3. Click Vaccinations, then Summary, then look at the Forecast at the bottom of the page.


