



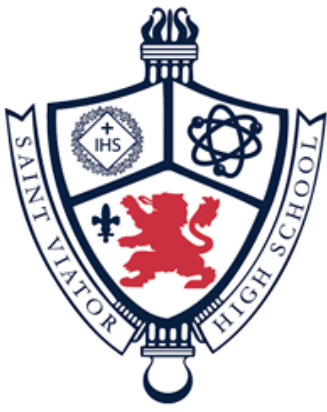

**Saturday, February 20th, 8:00 AM - 12:00 PM**

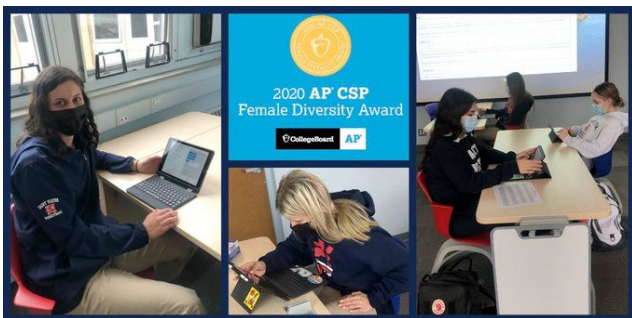
**Tuesday, February 23rd, 2:30 PM - 7:00 PM**

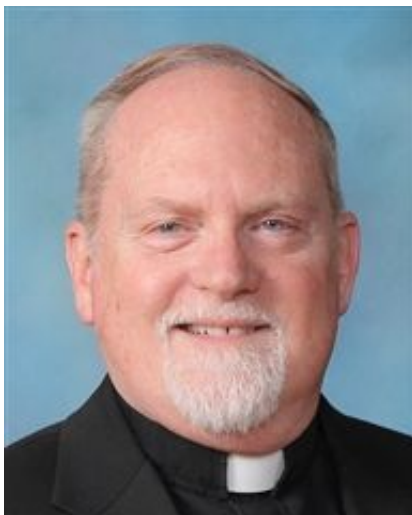


## International Student Service Project

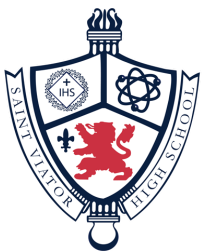
