



IS YOUR CHILD INTERESTED IN SPANISH CLASSES AFTER SCHOOL?

My name is Patricia Linares. I am originally from Costa Rica, and I have taught Spanish for 30 years. I am also District 95's Parent Liaison, Interpreter, and Translator.

Some parents have expressed an interest in paying extra so that their children receive enrichment classes and can practice their Spanish language skills in smaller groups after school.

If there are enough students (1st-8th), I will form a couple of groups, two afternoons per week from 2:20 to 3:20 p.m.. The cost is \$10, per class, per student, payable to St. Francis de Sales School.

If this schedule does not work out, I will be having Spanish Storytime at the Ela Library for free. Children who are 2-5 years old can attend the class on Thursdays from 1:00-2:00 p.m. (Sept. 6-Dec. 13). Children who are 6-10 years old can attend the class on the second and fourth Monday of every month from 4:00-5:00 p.m. (Sept. 10, 24; Oct. 8, 22; Nov. 12, 26; Dec. 10).
