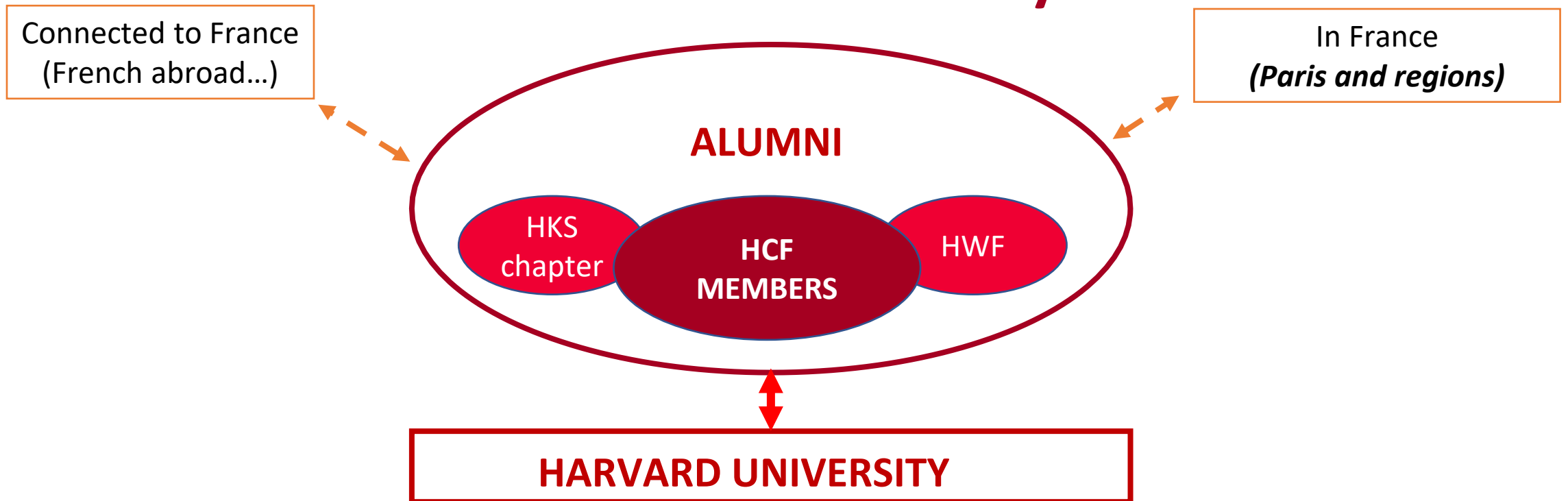

The HCF Mission

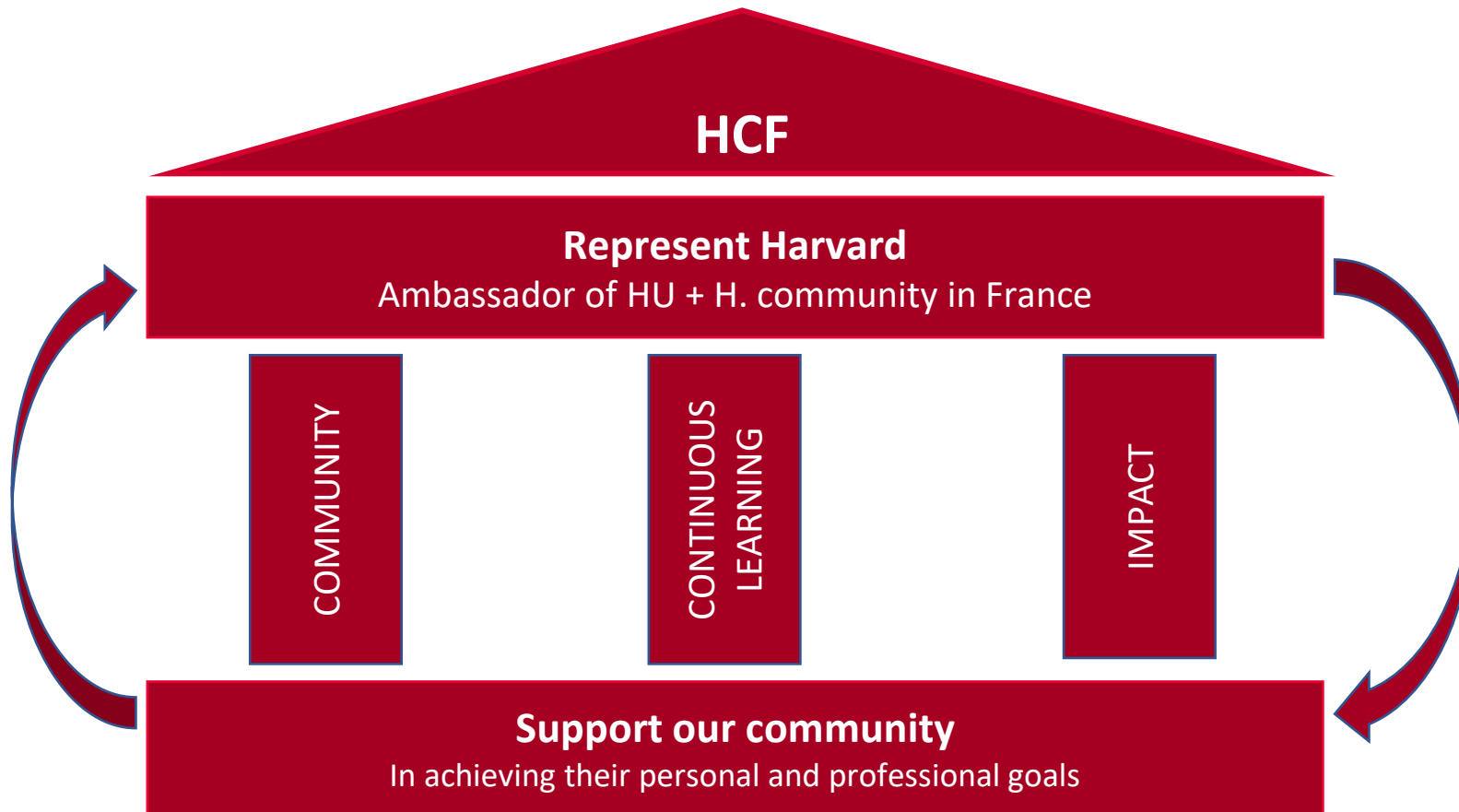
- Bring together the community of Harvard actors in France

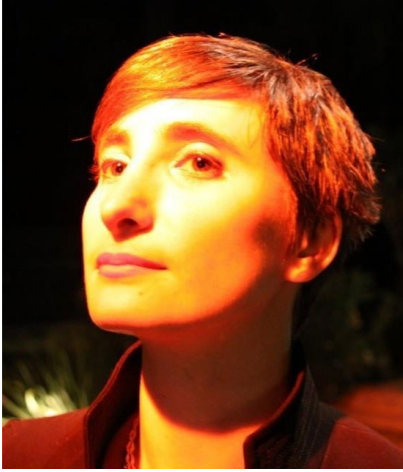

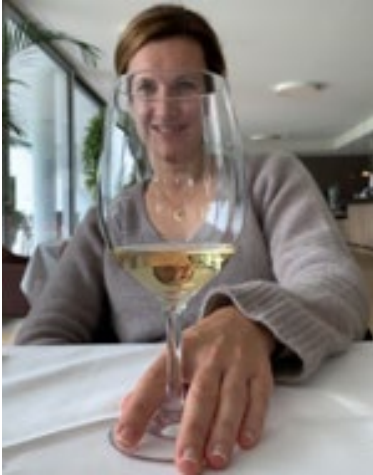
Our Team – NEW Member

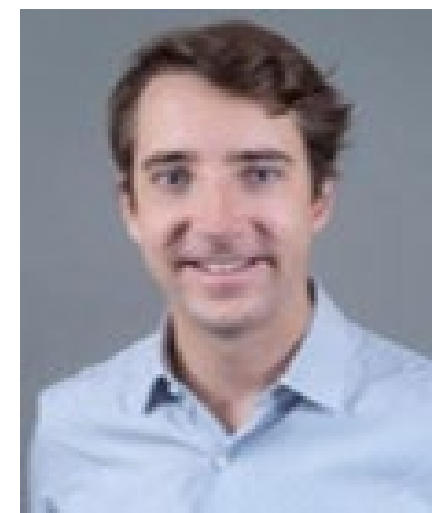

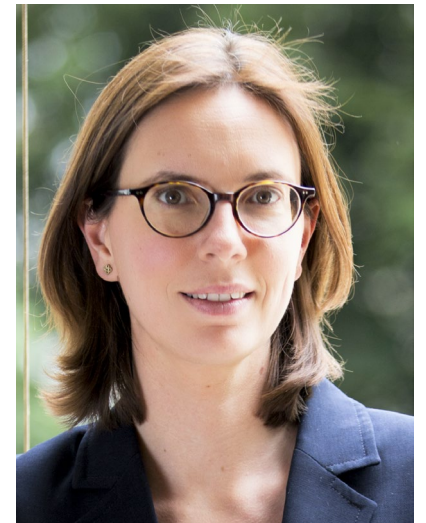

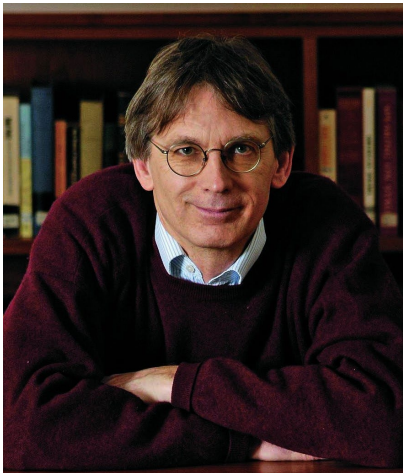
