The Executive Director serves as **Chief Administrative Officer** of UCMGH in the areas of board development, staff supervision, fiscal responsibilities, and communication. Administrative Support

- Maintain contact information for students and volunteers, donors, and supporters
- Work with the Board of Directors and committees to further the mission of UCMGH.

- Work with Treasurer to prepare Annual Budget
- Solicit donations
- Explore fundraising opportunities

- Submit information for campus communication newsletter
- Nurture and expand relationships with supporting congregations
- Provide periodic written updates for churches to include in newsletters and bulletins.
- Produce quarterly newsletters for the organization

The Executive Director serves as **Campus Minister** at the main campus of the University of Houston and any other campuses as needed. As Campus Minister, the ED is responsible for programming and student engagement.

Programming / Student Engagement

- Plan events and programs that support students' needs.
- Provide pastoral care to students and University Staff.
- Maintain communications and outreach to students and University Staff
- Establish and maintain relationships with other campus ministries and student organizations.
- Seek opportunities to collaborate with other campus ministers and departments on campus.

Some of the tasks listed here may be delegated to other staff, interns, student-officers, Board Members, or volunteers.

Compensation is based upon the candidate's qualification and experience as determined by the Board of Directors. Paid time off is included in the package.

Minimum candidate qualifications include:

- Undergraduate degree in Divinity or Theology from an accredited university is required.
 Candidates with experience in youth and young adult ministry, with an undergraduate degree in a different discipline will be considered.
- 2. Master's degree in Divinity, Theology or related field is preferred.
- 3. Ordination preferred. Minimum requirement: licensed or commissioned in one of the three sponsoring denominations: The Presbyterian Church, U.S.A., Christian Church (Disciples of Christ), and the United Church of Christ.
- 4. Experience mentoring college students.
- 5. An understanding of young adult spiritual development based on theoretical knowledge and practical experience.
- 6. A commitment to the spiritually grounded development of young adults necessary to engage in an increasingly multicultural society.
- 7. Non-profit administration skills including but not limited to board development, staff supervision, fiscal responsibilities, and program design, funding, and implementation.
