3. Council is asked to ratify the City Manager's execution of a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Columbia and the Fifth Circuit Public Defender's Office for Representation of Indigent Defendants, as requested by Municipal Court. Award to the Richland County Fifth Circuit Public Defender's Office in the amount of \$137,318.00.

Funding Source: Public Defender (1018404-638522). The original budget amount is \$137,318.00.



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4. Council is asked to approve the Renewal of Mobile Area Routing and Vehicle Location Information System (MARVLIS) Software Support, as requested by the Columbia Police Department. Award to Bradshaw Consulting Services, Inc. in the amount of \$75,417.90. This firm is located in Aiken, SC.

Funding Source: Police Administrative Services; Maintenance and Service Contract (1012402-638200). The original budget amount is \$75,417.90.

5. Council is asked to approve the purchase of a KWMI Diesel Easement Machine for the Wastewater Maintenance Division, as requested by the Fleet Services Division. Highfill Infrastructure Engineering, PC of Columbia, SC, is the protégé and will provide construction coordination, field reviews and inspection, coordination with City staff, and plan review services at 20.0% (\$27,198.00) of the total contract amount.

This is a Mentor Protégé Program Project. Michael Baker International, Inc. is the mentor and will provide project management, utility coordination, design, permitting, bidding assistance, construction management, and construction observation services at 69.1% (\$217,350.00) of the total contract amount. Chao & Associates, Inc., a Minority Business Enterprise of Columbia, SC, is the protégé and will provide utility coordination, design, permitting, and construction observation services at 22.1% (\$69,500.00) of the total contract amount.

BLD Services, LLC of Kenner, LA will provide service lateral and CIPP services at 26.4% (\$2,870,000.00) of the total contract value.



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United Specialty Construction, LLC of Lilburn, GA will provide point repairs at 1.8% (\$200,000.00) of the total contract value.
