How to schedule your permitted teenager for Alive at 25...

Step 1: go to <https://aliveat25.us/ky/find-a-course>

Step 2: Find available date, time and location (ZOOM AVAILABLE)

Step 3: Make sure to have permit information as it will be needed for next step

Step 4: Click “Enroll” in top right corner

Step 5: Enter information to “Register (New Student)”

Step 6: Follow prompts to fill in personal information and payment information

Step 7: Will receive confirmation email and reminder email

Step 8: Once completed course, make sure to print out certificate

Commonly asked question: Is Alive at 25 required in Kentucky?

In order to complete the Graduated Driver Licensing Program in Kentucky **you must be at least 16 years of age and a Kentucky Permit or Intermediate license holder**. Graduated Driver License classes are FREE to students that need to meet the 4-hour mandatory requirement.

3 options (Online, by mail or in person)

Online

Step 1: Go to <https://drive.ky.gov/Pages/default.aspx>

Step 2: Click "RENEW BY ONLINE"

Step 3: Select either "START DRIVER LICENSE RENEWAL" or "START ID CARD RENEWAL"

Step 4: Fill in all personal information and complete

Mail

Step 1: Click "RENEW BY MAIL"

Step 2: Print form

Step 3: Complete form and mail to: Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, Division of Driver Licensing, 200 Mero Street, Frankfort KY 40622

In Person

Step 1: Click "SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT"

Step 2: Find "FRANKFORT" and Click "SCHEDULE"

Step 3: Click "SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT" on pop up

Step 4: Find date and time

Step 5: Enter personal information

Step 6: Will receive confirmation email or text if signed up

Appointments will be taken before walk ins.**
