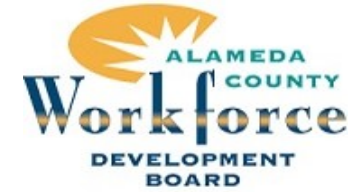


Request For Proposals: Adult and Dislocated Worker

Organizations Eligible to Apply: Eligible organizations include public and private non-profit community-based organizations, faith-based organizations, local education agencies, government agencies and for-profit agencies

Target Populations: Veterans and eligible spouses, public assistance recipients or otherwise low-income households, Basic Skills Deficient – including English Language Learners, individuals with disabilities and justice-involved individuals
