The cohort will be made up of sixteen faith leaders from rural congregations and those from urban/suburban congregations who seek to be allies.

WHAT?

Through twelve sessions over six months, program participants will develop a program of social transformation that will engage both their congregation and their community. Utilizing popular education pedagogy, we will learn from one another and from members of the community. Grounded in the story of Exodus, the cohort will engage in discussion, exploration and action, supported by readings from a diverse array of authors and practitioners.

We will begin virtually and, depending on the path of the pandemic and the comfort of the cohort, eventually shift to in-person.
