

FPC Mahopac Has New Interim Pastor and New Music Director

First Presbyterian Church of Mahopac (FPCM) has been blessed with a new Interim Pastor and a new Music Director. On September 10, First Presbyterian Church of Mahopac welcomed Jennifer Sung as the new Music Director. Rev. Glen Reichelderfer is the new Interim Pastor, who began his ministry here on September 24. Both new leaders bring a unifying sense of spiritual and social renewal to the congregation.

Ordained in 1989, Rev. Reichelderfer holds a MDiv. from the McCormick Seminary in Chicago, and a M.S.S.W. from the University of Wisconsin. Before coming to Mahopac, he was Associate Minister of Christ Presbyterian Church in Madison, Wisconsin for 15 years. He also served at Covenant House-Times Square in New York City and as the Director of Port Saint Vincent, a Homeless Shelter.

Pastor Glen will be Interim Pastor until a Designated Pastor is found and called by the church.

Besides her extensive experience in the musical direction of Christian Services, Jennifer's impressive credentials include:

- Music Director of Koreanischer Frauenchor Berlin

- Doctor of Musical Arts conferred in 2016
- Working proficiency in several languages, including Korean, German, French and Italian.

Jennifer plans to improve the FPCM music ministry by recruiting and coaching choir members and encouraging other talented members of the congregation to help provide special musical experiences.
