THURSDAY Lindsay (31.7 miles – Population 283)

- Initial Irish settlement, with establishment of post office in 1874.
- As with other towns in the region, coming of the railroad was critical to early growth.
- Emerged as a regional trade center, achieving a peak population of 490 in 1920.
- Major industry is the Lindsay Corporation, founded by Paul Zimmerman in 1955 and a manufacturer of irrigation and farm automation equipment sold worldwide. Acquisitions have diversified both the products and geography of Lindsay's operations.

- 31.8 mi Turn right (W) on 1st St.
- 32.0 mi Turn left (S) on Elm St. (Lindsay Highway)
- 47.8 mi Turn right (SW) on Highway N-22

Genoa (50.5 miles – Population 894)

- Designated the Pawnee Capital of Nebraska and was the home territory of the Pawnee nation, during back to the 1800s and before.
- The peaceful Pawnee tribe, once numbering as many as 60,000 people in the early 1700s, were decimated by disease borne by European migrants, crop failure, and attacks by aggressive tribes. Population had dropped to about 4,000 by 1860.
- First white settlers in area were Mormons in 1857, as Genoa became a waystation on the Mormon Trail, eventually becoming the city of Genoa.
- Table Creek Treaty signed by the Pawnees and the government gave up tribal claim to its Nebraska lands in exchange for protection and establishment of an Indian Agency. Agency set up shop in Mormon buildings after Mormons were forced to leave by the government's special agent for the Pawnees.


