The Fremont Fire Department is continually looking for ways to improve our emergency response to our community and surrounding area. A part of that improvement is updating our current pre-plans for the commercial properties that lie within our jurisdiction. In the past, this meant that we would have to gather business information including information about the building itself. We would have to make multiple paper copies to be distributed amongst our response vehicles. We are excited to announce that we are currently migrating to a new electronic platform that will allow us to quickly find the information on incident response. This will allow for a more efficient and effective response when the fire department arrives on scene knowing where the utilities and fire protection measures are located on your business property. Also important is knowing the type of construction, materials your business is made, and the contents within your business which helps our fire suppression efforts to minimize fire loss.

As a part of this effort, we would like to ask for a little help. Attached you will find the information sheet that is utilized by firefighters when they perform a pre-plan visit. We would like to ask you to fill out this form to the best of your knowledge and email it back to Assistant Chief Parsons, Adam.Parsons@fremontne.gov, subject line Pre-Plan. Our goal is to gain as much information as possible by reducing the amount of time that firefighters will need to complete this task. Every effort will be made to visit commercial properties so that we can add photographs, diagrams, and give our firefighters an opportunity to visit your business and see your building in person. As you can imagine we will not be able to visit every business within a year, so gaining some information now will allow us to update our current plans while implementing the new software.
