

Purpose: In response to the needs of individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD), their families and the individuals working with them, the Mississippi Department of Mental Health, Boswell Regional Center formed an Autism Services Division and a Curriculum Task Force. These entities are providing support to an Autism Statewide Training Initiative designed to build capacity in the state to provide evidence-based services and supports to individuals with ASD and their families across the lifespan.

About the Training: This two-day training will provide participants with an extensive foundation in ASD and is geared to produce the following learning outcomes:

- ⇒ Understanding of the characteristics of autism and their impact on individuals through the lifespan,
- ⇒ Skills in determining priorities and planning strategies to address them,
- ⇒ Skills in the design and use of visual strategies,
- ⇒ An understanding of sensory processing and strategies for meeting sensory needs,
- ⇒ Skills in environmental set-up and arrangement,
- ⇒ Skills in identifying and utilizing evidence-based practices in the areas of social, communication and behavior,
- ⇒ Strategies for effective teaming,
- ⇒ An awareness of state and national autism resources.
