KWAME NKRUMAH MEMORIAL PARK  
DRUMMING LESSON  
ARTS CENTER MARKET VISIT**

Breakfast at hotel. Depart for a sightseeing tour of Accra, the Capital of Ghana. Experience the city's highlights during this Accra orientation. The capital of Ghana since 1877, Accra is the country's most populous city.

Independence Arch is a national monument and part of Black Star Square. It was commissioned by Kwame Nkrumah in 1957 to celebrate Ghana's independence from British colonial rule.

We'll visit the Arts Center for a drumming lesson and demonstration. Hand carved drums will be available for purchase. Guests can sharpen their bargaining skills by shopping with local vendors.

Tour the Kwame Nkrumah Memorial Park, dedicated to the legacy of Ghana's first President, Kwame Nkrumah, and his role in African independence. The tour includes visits to Nkrumah's mausoleum, a museum showcasing his life, his personal residence, the Eternal Flame of African Liberation, and beautifully landscaped gardens.

**MANHYIA PALACE MUSEUM TOUR  
KENTE CLOTH WEAVING DEMO

NAMING CEREMONY**

Breakfast at hotel. Check out and depart to Accra International Airport for our flight to Kumasi. Kumasi is the capital of the Ashanti Kingdom.

Upon arrival, guests will tour the Manhyia Palace and Museum The palace features historical artifacts.

Next guests will experience a Kente weaving demonstration and cocoa and a talk about natural remedies.

Next guests will be dressed in Kente cloth and participate in a naming ceremony. An adult Ghanaian name is given to participants, and a gift presented as part of the celebration.

An adult Ghanaian naming ceremony symbolizes a "rebirth," providing individuals—particularly those in the African Diaspora—a profound reconnection to their heritage, ancestors, and a lost sense of identity. Held by elders, it involves receiving a "soul name" based on the birthday, signifying belonging, spiritual grounding, and community acceptance.

**DAY 4 – Cape Coast, Ghana**

**ASSIN MANSO – ANCESTRAL SLAVE RIVER WALK  
SLAVE DUNGEON TOUR (UNESCO World Heritage Site)**

Breakfast at hotel. We'll travel by road from Kumasi to Cape Coast.

We'll travel to Assin Manso to visit the site of "Donkor Nsuo," the former Slave River and market, the final transit point for enslaved Africans. During the transatlantic slave trade, it served as a major market and the "last bath" site where captured Africans were cleaned and prepared before marching to coastal dungeons.

After lunch on your own, continue with a tour of either Elmina or Cape Coast castle. Walk through the dark and suffocating dungeons where thousands of enslaved Africans were held before being forced onto ships. Stand in the Door of No Return, a symbolic gateway representing the final passage of those taken from their homeland.
