Notice: Upcoming Improvements

SE 17TH AVENUE CLOSURE AT LAS OLAS BOULEVARD

The City of Fort Lauderdale is working to improve traffic safety by closing SE 17th Avenue at Las Olas Boulevard. The change is intended to address line-of-sight concerns that neighbors have raised at the intersection.

With support from the Colee Hammock Home Owners Association, the City Commission directed staff to move forward with implementing the closure at the June 17, 2025, Commission meeting.

The closure will be installed using temporary materials as the City evaluates a potential long-term solution, subject to future funding. Recent traffic counts show low volumes along SE 17th Avenue, so the impact on the neighborhood will be minimal.

Construction is expected to begin the week of August 18th, 2025, and will take place Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. This schedule is subject to change based on weather or other unforeseen conditions.
