BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT
State Road (SR) 736/ Davie Boulevard Bridge
over the South Fork of the New River
Broward County, Florida

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will conduct a public meeting for the above referenced project within Broward County. This public meeting will be offered in-person and virtually simultaneously. The public meeting will have representatives available to answer questions.

Project information will be available for public viewing. Questions and comments may be submitted prior to the meeting by contacting the Project Manager. PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The purpose of the project is to rehabilitate and extend the service life of the existing bridge. This will increase the resiliency of our infrastructure and promote the movement of goods and people.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Replace important electrical components and wiring
- Replace span locks which connect the two halves of the movable bridge deck when the bridge is in the “down” position
- Renovate the bridge tender house
- Repair the existing navigation/marine fenders in the waterway, including replacement of the decking and wales
- Modify generator platform
- Improve maintenance access to electrical and mechanical components
- Minor sidewalk deck modifications
- Spot paint fascia elements as needed
- Repair seawall to prevent bank erosion
- Upgrade lighting at the bridge to enhance safety for nighttime users of the corridor
- Minor repaving of the roadway at ends of the bridge

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Work will be done in phases to minimize impacts to the community
- Full and partial bridge closures will occur only during specific phases and detours will be provided utilizing Riverland Rd., US 1/Federal Highway, and SR 842/Broward Boulevard
- Full bridge closures will occur during non-peak (i.e. nighttime) hours, and will not occur during major special events
- Each phase requiring a full (nighttime only) or partial bridge closure is expected to be one month or less
- Temporary lane closures will be required for some phases (such as minor repaving) and will occur during non-peak hours
- Pedestrian traffic will be maintained on the side of the bridge opposite from any ongoing construction
- Access to properties on both sides of the bridge will be maintained during construction
- Another public meeting (Construction Open House) will be held prior to construction. Detailed information about how to keep informed of potential construction impacts will be provided at this meeting
- Marine vessel traffic will be maintained with temporary closure on half the channel during fender construction
- Modification to the draw bridge operation schedule will be coordinated with the United States Coast Guard
